



2nd Annual Trinity Academy Used Textbook Sale!

The sale is designed to assist families in selling and purchasing used textbooks required for high school classes (10th-12th grades). Books can also be donated as part of the “scholarship” book option.

Who*: Upper school families may participate as follows:

- Current 10th-12th grade families may sell/donate.
- Rising 10th- 12th grade families may purchase.

**Rising 7th-9th grade families will have an opportunity to purchase and/or sell summer reading books but the sale is primarily for textbooks used by sophomores, juniors, and seniors.*

When: The sale is Monday, June 25th from 9am-3:30pm.

Books for sale or donation may be dropped off in room 201 in the Math & Science building beginning June 14th through next Thursday, June 21st between the hours of 9am-3:30pm.

Where: Math & Science Building hallway

How: Please read all of the information below as it contains pertinent information to ensure a smooth and successful event for all.

IF YOU ARE SELLING OR DONATING:

1. Gather your child’s books using the attached book lists to ensure that the book will be used again next year. In most instances, this is the case.

It is important to note that NOT ALL OF YOUR CHILD’S BOOKS MAY BE ELIGIBLE for resale. Some books are consumables and cannot be reused. Other books are being replaced with newer editions next year. And lastly, the English department has

requested that student novels are each of the same ISBN number. This makes it much easier for both student and teacher when all are literally “on the same page.”

2. Once you’ve determined that the textbook is eligible, make an adhesive label or post-it note for the inside front cover of the book using the following criteria:

Your name (NOT your child’s)
Title of book (in case label falls off)
Amount* requested or DONATE**

**Please use whole dollar amounts only!*

***Amount is totally up to you based upon your original purchase price. If you would like to donate, simply write DONATE instead of a sale price.*

3. Drop off your books in room 201 (Math & Science) between June 14th- June 21st (9am-3:30pm).

Please plan to retrieve any books not sold and collect your earnings on June 27th or 28th between 9am-3:30pm —please check-in at the Front Office and ask for Kristen Stowe. If you are unable to retrieve your items on the designated days, please email Kristen Stowe at kstowe@trinityacademy.com to make alternate arrangements. Any unclaimed books will be used for donations.

IF YOU ARE SHOPPING:

1. Shop on Monday, June 25th from 9am-3:30pm.
2. A copy of each student’s class registration form will be available to help you shop. Electives will likely not be determined by then, but very few elective courses need textbooks, so you’ll be prepared with all you need to shop for your child’s core subject areas.
3. Please use the provided book lists, which include specific information for the correct edition/ISBN numbers.
4. There are two ways to pay for your books:
 - Check – a separate check is required for each seller, so bring multiples
 - Cash – exact amounts only. There will not be a way to make change.
