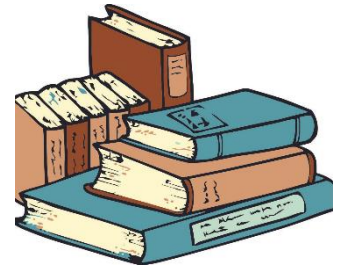


Summer Reading Reserved Titles List
