Guest Registration for Homecoming Dance, Winter Dance and Prom

All guests of students attending social functions must be registered in advance. No guest older than twenty years of age may attend and all policies, standards and rules, applicable to Trinity students are also applicable to the guest for the duration of the event.

- <u>Honor and Integrity</u>: The guest is expected to treat all faculty, staff, students and parents of Trinity with dignity and respect. All adults should be addressed honestly, immediately and forthrightly. Polite interaction, modesty, humility and kindness are values of the community and necessary of guests.
- 2. <u>Safety and Security</u>: No alcohol, tobacco or nicotine vapor devices, drug or related paraphernalia or weapons of any kind are permitted. The guest is expected to follow the directives of all faculty staff and chaperones.
- 3. Dress Code and Attire:
 - a. <u>Gentlemen</u>: For Homecoming a suit or sport coat and dress slacks, collared shirt and dress shoes are appropriate attire. Ties are recommended. Torn clothing and hats are not permitted. For prom, formal attire is the standard. For winter dance, khakis and a nice shirt. Suits are not expected.
 - b. <u>Ladies</u>: Dresses are to be no shorter than fingertip length in both front and back, including slits. Dresses should not be low cut or revealing. Clothing should fit appropriately, not extremely tight or form fitting. Clothing should not reveal the midriff or be sheer or see through.
